

## Reception Learning Objectives

Autumn Term w/b 16<sup>th</sup> September

This week in school we will be learning...

**English** – We will continue looking at familiar nursery rhymes and practising our letter formation of the sounds we have learnt already.

**Phonics** – (Please see sheet below.)

**Maths** – We will be continuing to quantify sets of objects by subitising, rather than counting. We will be focusing on children being able to say how many there are in a small group of objects by 'just seeing' and knowing straightaway without needing to count.

**Understanding of the World** – To be able to talk about how we have grown up since being babies. We will also be talking about our families. Please feel free to send in family photos for us to share and display in the classroom.

Over the next two weeks in school we will be learning...

**Communication and Language** – To be able to listen to others one on one or in a small group. We will also be continuing to understand the use of objects and tools in our learning environment to build independence.

**Physical Development** – To develop their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently. We will be practising with lots of different tools to prepare them for the correct pencil grip.

**PSED** – To be able to see themselves as valuable individuals. We will be continuing to get to know the children and their families.

**Expressive Arts and Design** – To be able to use different tools and materials to create. We will be looking at parts of a body, e.g. bones, muscles, brain and using different materials to create these parts.

### Notes

This half term our topic is 'All About Me' which will include learning about how we develop as we grow older. If any parent has a new baby that they would like to bring in and talk to the children about, please contact your class teacher to arrange a visit.

Within this topic, we will be learning about people who help us. If any parent works within the community e.g. police officer, nurse, vet and would come in to talk to the children about their job, please contact your child's class teacher.

### Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



#### Pronunciation Phrase - i

Pull your lips back and make the i sound at the back of your mouth i i i



#### Pronunciation Phrase - n

Open your lips a bit, put your tongue behind your teeth and make the nnnnn sound nnnnn



#### Pronunciation Phrase - m

Put your lips together and make the mmmmm sound mmmmm



#### Pronunciation Phrase - d

Put your tongue to the top and front of your mouth and make a quick d d d

*We will be orally blending words. Can you hear the phonemes in these words? Can you listen and then repeat the word?*
